We're pleased to present the 10th anniversary conference for the **2015 Georgia BigPictureCon!** The film and technology conference will be held Sunday and Monday, Oct. 18-19 at Clayton State University in Morrow, Ga. The BigPictureCon is an annual educational summit that provides opportunities for emerging filmmakers and industry technology professionals to connect with one another and participate in a variety of educational sessions on topics like filmmaking, production technology, and innovations in digital media and web entertainment. Students in any discipline, emerging and professional filmmakers, animators, editors, writers, storytellers, audio technicians, game developers, special effects artisans, and digital media specialists are all welcome to attend.

DESCRIPTION

The Georgia BigPictureCon is an exciting 2-day Film & Technology Conference developed by The Big Picture Film & Video Foundation (The Foundation). Conference sessions encourage the power and use of storytelling through film and screen-based media as a vehicle for personal expression, problem-solving and cultural understanding. One objective of the foundation and the conference is to enable local film and visual arts organizations to tap into and utilize the growing local student population as a 'second string' of talent which will help independent filmmakers and producers maintain a competitive edge. The BigPictureCon as a conference offers emerging filmmakers, digital media developers, and professionals in the digital entertainment space opportunities to meet and learn from other industry insiders; to assist

them in developing relationships, leading to possible future project collaboration where such opportunities may have been more difficult to come by before.

The Georgia BigPictureCon is targeted to emerging, student and professional filmmakers, animators, editors, writers, audio techs, game developers, animators, special and visual effects artisans, and digital media specialists. All are welcome!

SHORT FILM FESTIVAL

The Georgia BigPictureCon Short Film Festival is a special feature of the 2-day BigPictureCon. The festival was designed to allow student and emerging filmmakers a chance to have their work showcased at a venue where professionals and peers are present to evaluate their talent and vision, and where they can network and access opportunities for professional development. Films will be evaluated by an esteemed jury of industry professionals, such as film festival programmers and established filmmakers, based on judging criteria which takes into account elements such as quality of story line, creativity, production quality, acting, soundtrack and editing.

Anyone can submit a short film on any topic. However, the piece must be family-friendly (PG or G-rated), with no grotesque violence, nudity, or other inappropriate content. Films cannot be more than 10 minutes in length. Experienced and emerging filmmakers are encouraged to submit short films of up to 10 minutes in length in categories including drama, comedy, music video, and PSAs, among others. Filmmakers of entries *selected for screening* will receive two All Access conference passes. Extended submission deadline is **September 12, 2015.** For details and to submit a film, visit BigPictureCon.com.
